


Activating the Philips Vesta's microphone

This section describes how to activate the built-in microphone of the Philips Vesta (Pro) PC camera.

Make sure the camera's microphone is used for recording


Go to **Audio Properties** by right-clicking the speaker on your taskbar and selecting **Adjust Audio Properties**.




Select **Philips VGA Digital Camera; Aud** as preferred recording device. The checkbox **Use only preferred devices** should be flagged.

Turn up the recording volume


Open the **Volume Control** by double-clicking the speaker on your taskbar. Go to the **Options** menu and select **Properties**.



Select **Philips VGA Digital Camera; Aud** as mixer device.




After the **Philips VGA Digital Camera; Aud** is selected as the mixer device, click on "recording".



In the white box, it is shown that the volume control of the Philips camera microphone can be set.

Then click **OK**



Now you can control the recording volume of the camera's microphone. Make sure it is NOT muted (checkboxbox not flagged). The volume slider should not be fully slid down.
